



Fernando Puntigliano is Professor for Logistics and Supply Chain at the School of Business of the Universidad Católica del Uruguay. He is also Director of CPR Ludwig, a project, engineering, logistics, environmental and finances consultant firm. He was recently State Environmental Minister of Montevideo and between 2005 and 2009 President of the Uruguayan Ports. Puntigliano was CEO of port operations firms in Uruguay, mining companies in Brazil and Uruguay, Head of Operating Facilities in aerospace business in Germany and Project Manager at various research institutes in Germany and Uruguay. In 2003 he was awarded with the National German Prize of Naval Architecture and Marine Engineering Curt Bartsch. Puntigliano was also interim President of the Uruguayan Railway Administration and Member of the Board of the Central Bank of Uruguay.
